# Requirements

Candidates who have previously applied to Master's programs at Bocconi University – regardless of the outcome of their application – are not eligible for CATÓLICA-LISBON Double Degree programs with Bocconi University.

Candidates of any nationality (or nationalities) who hold an Italian bachelor/undergraduate degree are not eligible for CATÓLICA-LISBON Double Degree programs with Bocconi University.

# Study Plan at CATÓLICA-LISBON

Double Degree programs include a tailor-made study plan according to the MSc program and chosen specialization. The detailed study plan will be provided to students before the course enrollment period and includes foundation, specialization, elective courses and a Third Language Requirement (this requirement can be fulfilled by any of the extensive language courses offered at CATÓLICA-LISBON or by the mandatory Italian course at Bocconi).

In addition, students must attend <u>Career Accelerator Lab Workshops</u> designed to develop professional and career skills and complete <u>2 LERNE sessions</u> (a Laboratory for Experimental Research Center).

Before going to Bocconi University, CATÓLICA-LISBON students have also to complete the Research Methodologies Workshop which will provide useful tools for writing the Master Dissertation.

During their 1st year at CATÓLICA-LISBON, Double Degree students must complete at least **60 ECTS** before continuing their studies at Bocconi University.

# **Study Plan at Bocconi**

For the 2<sup>nd</sup> year of the Double Degree program, the study plan at Bocconi University will include mandatory and elective courses, a language requirement, an enhancing experience, a Behavioural Skills Seminar and a dissertation. More details on the study plan will be provided to students while still at CATÓLICA-LISBON.

At the end of the Double Degree program, all courses passed both at CATÓLICA-LISBON and Bocconi will count towards the student's final GPA and CATÓLICA-LISBON's Diploma. CATÓLICA-LISBON uses the ECTS system, and all courses will be converted according to the University's grade and credit system.

### > Language Requirement

Students are required to pass two foreign language exams at Bocconi. The first will be **English** (C1 Level), and students can fulfill this requirement by either taking the English proficiency exam at Bocconi, which is a pass/fail course worth 2 ECTS, or by submitting a valid language certificate accepted by the Bocconi Language Center, with a list of accepted English certificates available <a href="here">here</a>. The second exam will be an **Italian** course (B2 Level), which is mandatory for non-native speakers.

# Internship

CATÓLICA-LISBON has a requirement for a noncredit company **internship** with a minimum duration of **6 weeks (240 hours)**. Prior professional experience can also be used to fulfill the internship requirement if completed after June 1st of the year before the beginning of the MSc program.

Bocconi also as a curricular internship requirement with a minimum length is **8 weeks full-time** (or 11 weeks part-time). Previously completed internships, if in line with the student's course of study/duration requirements may be validated.

Although with different durations, students can submit the same experience(s) for both internship requirements.















### **Dissertation**

During their 2<sup>nd</sup> year of studies, students write **one dissertation** that should be submitted **to both schools**. The dissertation will be developed with the support of a supervisor of the Host University. Although no co-advisor from CATÓLICA-LISBON is necessary for the dissertation development, the dissertation must **fulfill the requirements of both schools**.

Students must defend their dissertation at both schools, according to the rules and timing set by each institution. The defense at CATÓLICA-LISBON takes place upon completing their study plan, including credited courses from Bocconi, and settling their treasury situation.

Double Degree programs award two diplomas, each issued independently by the respective institutions based on their rules and timelines. CATÓLICA-LISBON's final certificate can be requested immediately after the dissertation defense, while the diploma is awarded during the Graduation Ceremony, usually in November.
