# Study Plan at CATÓLICA-LISBON

Double Degree programs include a tailor-made study plan according to the MSc program and chosen specialization. The detailed study plan will be provided to students before the course enrollment period and includes foundation, specialization, elective courses and a Third Language Requirement.

In addition, students must attend <u>Career Accelerator Lab Workshops</u> designed to develop professional and career skills and complete <u>2 LERNE sessions</u> (a Laboratory for Experimental Research Center).

Before going to Smith, CATÓLICA-LISBON students have also to complete the Research Methodologies Workshop which will provide useful tools for writing the Master Dissertation.

During their 1st year at CATÓLICA-LISBON, Double Degree students must complete at least **60 ECTS** before continuing their studies at Smith.

## **Study Plan at Smith**

For the 2<sup>nd</sup> year of the program, the <u>study plan</u> will include mandatory and elective courses, as well as a Group Business Project at Smith School of Business. More details on the study plan will be provided to students while still at CATÓLICA-LISBON.

At the end of the Double Degree program, all courses passed both at CATÓLICA-LISBON and Smith will count towards the student's final GPA and CATÓLICA-LISBON's diploma. CATÓLICA-LISBON uses the ECTS system, and all courses will be converted according to the University's grade and credit system.

#### > Group Business Project

The Group Business Project is an opportunity for organizations to receive comprehensive analysis to help solve a global business issue or challenge. Students will work asynchronously in cross-cultural and geographically dispersed teams to conduct research and deliver a consulting report that helps solve a business challenge.

#### **Dissertation**

During their 2<sup>nd</sup> year of studies, students write **one dissertation** that should be submitted **to CATÓLICA-LISBON only**. Canadian Master's programs do not require a dissertation.

The dissertation will be developed with the support of a supervisor from CATÓLICA-LISBON, during the  $2^{\rm nd}$  semester of the  $2^{\rm nd}$  year of studies. Further details on the dissertation process will be provided to students during their  $1^{\rm st}$  year of studies at CATÓLICA-LISBON.

Students may choose to stay in Canada for one or two semesters. However, a full year in Kingston is strongly recommended for a complete Double Degree experience. CATÓLICA-LISBON provides all dissertation guidance and supervision remotely, allowing students to stay in Canada or return to Portugal.

Students must defend their dissertation at CATÓLICA-LISBON, according to the rules and timing set. The defense takes place upon completing their study plan, including credited courses from Smith, and settling their treasury situation.

Double Degree programs award two diplomas, each issued independently by the respective institutions based on their rules and timelines. CATÓLICA-LISBON's final certificate can be requested immediately after the dissertation defense, while the diploma is awarded during the Graduation Ceremony, usually in November.


# **Scholarships**
