#### \*Learn in Action Program\*

The Learn in Action Program is a soft-skill and career development program included in the compulsory study plan, exclusively designed for our undergraduate students.

It develops "hands-on" skills that are a crucial complement to academic knowledge and prepares you for the entry in a global job market and an outstanding career. A range of personal skills as well as preparation for recruitment processes will be addressed by experienced and specialized speakers.

It also includes the chance to engage in extra-curricular activities that develop key competences for a successful professional future: internships, volunteering and entrepreneurship projects.

#### You are required to:

• Complete **3 ECTS** (you will have to engage in different activities that grant you Points and collect 42 Points that will then be converted into 3 ECTS), and complete the mandatory requirements (below).

#### **Mandatory Requirements:**

- approved CV in the careerNETwork platform
- Oral and Written Communication workshop
- one personal development workshop (choose among topics available)
- one recruitment workshop (choose among topics available)
- one job market knowledge activity (choose among different activities, including validation of an internship, volunteering or entrepreneurship project)

#### **Optional**

You may add up to 1 ECTS more (to the mandatory 3 ECTS) if you choose to validate an internship, volunteering or entrepreneurship project – depending on the length, these can be worth between 6 and 18 Points.
